

2008 Section Chief Goals:

- Increase the responsibilities of the section officers in running the section and planning conclave.
- Maintain effective communication among the key-3 through regular phone calls and emails, as well as 3-way calls when necessary. Invite the section vice chief and section associate adviser(s) to participate in key-3 decisions whenever possible
- Maintain effective communication among the Council of Chiefs through regular phone calls and emails, as well as regularly scheduled COC meetings, including two teleconferences, one regional meeting (WA/OR & ID), and one retreat/onsite.
- Improve communication within the section by appointing and utilizing a section webmaster and web adviser who will be responsible for updating and maintaining the website. Work with the section secretary to find authors and editors for the content on the website.
- Regularly communicate with all lodge chiefs and CVCs to ensure that everything is going well in the section. Offer and provide assistance whenever possible.
- Work with the section vice chief to implement a new Lodge Assistance Program within the section.
- Work with Ma-I-Shu in order to include them in section and national events, including successfully co-hosting Conclave 2008.
- Appoint and utilize CVC advisers to support the CVCs in their work.
- Appoint and utilize assistant CVCs to work with the CVCs in accomplishing their goals and serve as a member of their committee. Encourage all CVCs to recruit and utilize multi-member committees to accomplish their goals.
- Work with CVCs to develop planning deadlines and ensure that they stay on schedule
- Appoint an Executive Committee to support the section officers in their duties, as well as to serve as a resource for CVCs and advisers who want input from Arrowmen experienced at the section level.
- Appoint and utilize a High Adventure chairman and adviser responsible for working with the lodge ArrowCorps⁵ chairman to promote and organize the section's attendance at AC⁵. They are also responsible for promotion of the OA National High Adventure Programs.
- Personally do everything in my power to get Arrowmen from Section W-1C to attend ArrowCorps⁵. Do everything in my power to make ArrowCorps⁵ a success and a worthwhile event for Arrowmen to attend.
- Be an example and source of inspiration to all I meet during my term.
